NEW GLASSES COLLECTION PROCEDURES

Praise the Lord, we are receiving hundreds of pairs of glasses, and since we are currently living in a very small rental home, we need to ask for your help. Until funds are received for more equipment and more space is available to spread out we must send the glasses to a processing center. Currently the glasses are sent to Louisville, KY for reconditioning. If possible,

please help us do a little leg work prior to shipping the glasses. First, clean the glasses in a dishwasher. You can usually clean about fifty pair at a time stacking them on top of each other with each layer 90 degrees from the other layer. Place them folded and sideways with the fingers of the dishwasher through the temples of the glasses. When glasses are dry pack them in boxes with a layer of bubble wrap or newspaper between each layer. Please do not wrap each pair of glasses individually. This takes a long time to unwrap. Please lay the glasses flat with the temples crossed as though you were laying them on your night stand before going to bed. This is how the glasses must be submitted to the processing center.

Once received at the processing center the prescription of the glasses are determined and a barcode label is generated. The frames are then placed in standard alignment and nose pads and screws are replaced if necessary. The glasses are then bagged and sent back to Eyes On Christ to be placed in our inventory.

Please do not use shredded paper or packing peanuts. These materials stick to the glasses. Please do not include glasses cases. Cases are bulky and take up valuable space. There is a company that donates brand new cases for every pair of glasses. Likewise, please do not send loose lenses, frames with missing lenses or severely broken glasses. If glasses are only missing screws and you have all of the pieces, place the pieces in a zip lock baggie and ship them to us. We appreciate all you do to help the ministry. This will allow us to make the best use of our time and resources. Of course, if you are unable to prepare the glasses in this way, send them on and we will take care of it for you. If you have any questions, please feel free to call.

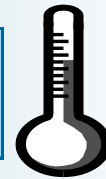
